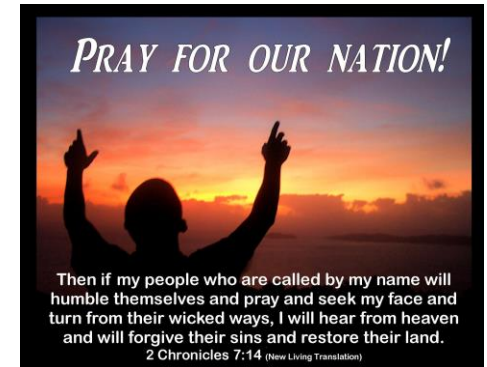

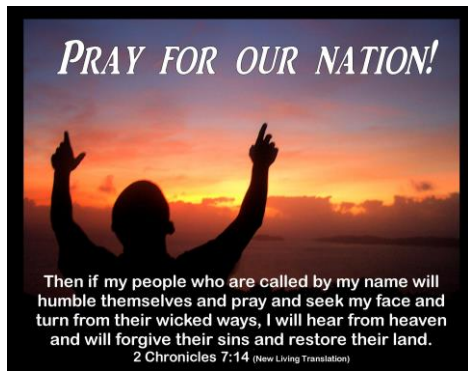


## Our Mission Statement:
